

Avera vCNE Acute Care Series - Avera ACO Update

Program Goal

The vCNE Series is specially designed to update nurses working in Ambulatory care settings on hot topics, evidence based practice and Avera's current strategic initiatives. Avera's ACO has been in practice for a number of years now and this session will review this model of care delivery and the impact nurses can have in their roles and understanding.
