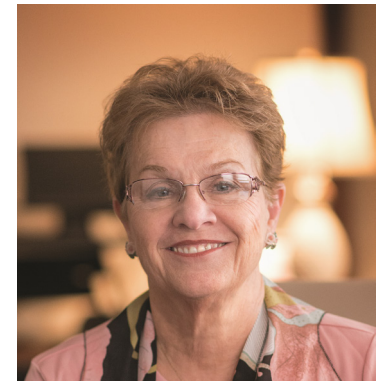

Goal:
