eCare: Process for Constant Observation of Suicidal and High Risk Patients

Program Goal

Patients are at risk for many things- including personal safety, self harm, or suicide As care providers, the goal is to ensure the utmost safety for the patients and staff in all situations Additionally, The Joint Commission and CMS have detailed requirements for ensuring safe and secure environments for patients at risk for suicide in hospital settings. This education will explain what the process and requirements are for constant observers in a hospital setting. Additional aspects of this education will be highlighting appropriate therapeutic communication techniques and how to create a safe environment for at risk and suicidal patients in the hospital.

Nursing Objectives

- 1 Identify warning signs resulting in safety concerns for at risk/suicidal patients
- 2 Identify forms of therapeutic communication to utilize when communicating with at risk/suicidal patients
- 3 Understand the different levels of observation
- 4 Understand the role and responsibilities of being a constant observer including preparing the room environment, diet, and visitor restrictions

Outcome

100 % of participants will demonstrate knowledge of the requirements of being a constant observer/sitter by passing post-test with score of \geq 80%.
