eCare Behavioral Health: Suicide Screening, Risk, and Prevention

<u>Program Goal:</u> Suicide is the 10th leading cause of death with nearly half a million people presenting to emergency room's in the United States each year following a suicide attempt. Early detection of suicide risk is critical for prevention.
