

What is Palliative Care?

Purpose: Learners will understand the difference between Palliative Medicine care and other end of life services.

- Objectives:**
- 1 Define palliative care, including how it is delivered, what patients need it, and how it differs from hospice.
 - 2 State the role of a palliative approach for seriously ill patients that includes both an inpatient and outpatient settings.
 - 3 At conclusion of the educational activity, participants will identify examples of patient populations who may benefit from a palliative approach to care.
 - 4 At three (3) months post-program evaluation, participants will self-report use recall of knowledge what is included in a palliative approach to patient care.
