Myths Debunked!

<u>Myth:</u> Education developed to meet a regulatory requirement does not qualify for Continuing Education credits.

<u>Reality:</u> Any education developed because of a regulatory requirement may qualify for Continuing Education credits. If there is a gap identified that can be addressed by developing education, it will qualify for CE credits. If you have quality data that fits into this category, please reach out to the CE Team to inquire on how to get CE credits put on this education.
